Counselor Job Description

Position Title: Counselor

Supervisor: MST Project Leader

Work Hours: Dependant upon status (i.e. volunteer, short-term / long-term staff)

Minimum time commitment: 2 years +

Summary of duties:

You are responsible for counseling men (if asked) that we meet in the red-light district. You will help with counseling of volunteers and outreach teams. You will be asked to arrange follow-up conversations with men, demonstrating effective counseling techniques during such conversations as well as sharing Christ's truth.

Essential job functions:

- Review MST Project staff and volunteer applications.
(Reads over MST Project applications regarding potential new staff and volunteers. Reviews and prays over applications with other staff to determine acceptance)
- Assist with accountability of MST Project staff and volunteers.
(During briefing and debriefing time, as well as with other staff members)
- Creative and intuitive MST Project ideas and development.
(Brainstorms new ideas for better outreach methodology in conjunction with other staff)
- MST Project staff responsibilities as described in the staff manual.
- Possible need for further training and education.
(College degree and past experience working in counseling)
- Counseling education and training required with a focus on sexual addiction, abuse, and/or addictive behavior.
- Follow-up conversations with men.
(Contacting and arranging meeting time and places with men)

All staff are expected to adhere to the rules, guidelines, and procedures as presented in the *Staff Manual* and to achieve a standard of work ethic as described in the *Initial Staff Review*.

Qualifications:

- Male (25 years +).
- Degree and experience in counseling.
- Active listening skills.
- Ability and desire to coordinate meetings with men, and travel to meet them.
- Thai language schooling based upon the requirements of the YWAM Thailand Culture and Language Phase.
- Ability to stay up late during nights of outreach.
