Prayer, Worship, and Intercession Job Description

Position Title: Prayer, Worship, and Intercessor

Supervisor: MST Project Leader

Work Hours: Dependant upon status (i.e. volunteer, short-term / long-term staff)

Minimum time commitment: 3 months +

Summary of duties:

You are responsible for leading prayer times in the prayer center during outreach. You will lead prayer walks through the red-light districts with team members. You will brief and debrief volunteers and outreach teams in a time of prayer and praise.

Essential job functions:

- Review MST Project staff and volunteer applications.
(Reads over MST Project applications regarding potential new staff and volunteers. Reviews and prays over applications with other staff to determine acceptance)
- Lead and help organize prayer walks and lead the prayer center during ministry.
(Prayer walks through red-light areas with teams and intercessory mobile prayer teams during ministry, as well as prayer center time)
- Lead times of prayer and intercession before and after ministry.
(Leading teams and staff in songs and prayers)
- Lead and organize times of worship.
(Extra-ministry prayer times for teams and staff)
- Assist with accountability of MST Project staff and volunteers.
(During briefing and debriefing time, as well as with other staff members)
- Creative and intuitive MST Project ideas and development.
(Brainstorms new ideas for better outreach methodology in conjunction other staff)
- MST Project staff responsibilities as described in the staff manual.

All staff are expected to adhere to the rules, guidelines, and procedures as presented in the *Staff Manual* and to achieve a standard of work ethic as described in the *Initial Staff Review*.

Qualifications:

- Male or Female (18 years +).
- Ability to sing, play the guitar, and lead in times of praise and worship.
- Leadership skills for prayer times and prayer walks.
- Prepared to engage in spiritual warfare.
- Thai language schooling based upon the requirements of the YWAM Thailand Culture and Language Phase.
- Ability to stay up late during nights of outreach.
